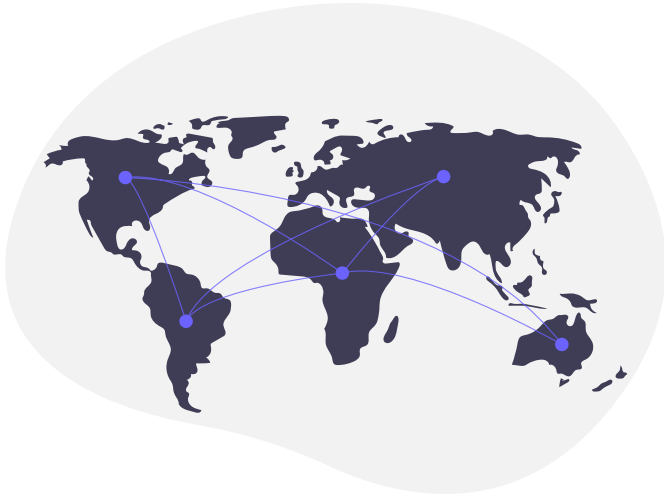

- Erosion of trust over the years in the power and the value of the internet as a tool



The State of Things

- Privacy and Data issues
- Misinformation
- Decline in the User Experience
- Technical Issues



What is a Next Generation Internet?

- For the European Union as an institution:
 - Protection of personal data
 - Guarantees of privacy and security
 - Combats disinformation
 - Guarantees user freedom and access
 - Respects fundamental rights
 - Enforces ethics and sustainability



The NGI Zero Initiative

- Support Free Software projects with funding and technical support from a consortium of various organizations.
- Approved software projects must have some potential to improve the internet as a platform in some way.



Examples of Supported Projects

- **CryptPad** - private-by-design online collaboration tool with built-in data encryption
- **SearX** - do-not-track search tool that unifies private and personal data search
- **Consento** - decentralized digital vault for managing confidential data using P2P encrypted storage
- **WorldBrain.io** - browser extension that tackles misinformation with collective web intelligence.

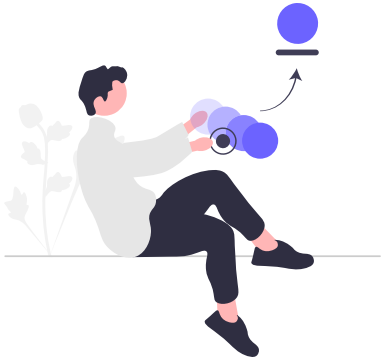
