



- Centralized Platforms
- No interaction among users of different platforms
- Mostly Ad driven pushing relevant postings to keep users online
- Moderation issues
- What happens if the platform is sold and the new owner is not so cool?






Illustration of the Expanded-Instances network Lucio La Cava et al. 2021

- Open Standards and Free Software




